Transfer Application V-10, in the name of E.E. Varco, proposed a change in place of use of water from Snow Creek and Three Creek, and storage from Big and Little Three Creek Lakes under a certain right with a priority date of March 8, 1923 for Snow Creek and Three Creek and September 12, 1936 for storage from Big and Little Three Creek Lakes for irrigation of 14.0 acres SW1/4 NW1/4, Section 10, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM.

The order of the State Engineer, predecessor of the Water Resources Director, entered May 14, 1951, approving Transfer Application V-10, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1952.

On May 23, 1989, Rosella W. Baker, Trustee for Newel P. and Rosella W. Baker Trust, submitted an affidavit that the Baker Trust is the owner of the land and has abandoned the water right and request it be cancelled.

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order and continued. Therefore, the subject water right has been lost.
