ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7151 submitted by

GRANDE RONDE VALLEY IMPROVEMENT DITCH COMPANY 205 MAIN STREET La GRANDE, OREGON 97850.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 32245, was perfected under Permit 25403 with a date of priority of JANUARY 23, 1958. The right allows the use of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 127.62 ACRES. This right is limited to 2.0 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW% SE%, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 38 E, WM; 350 FEET NORTH AND 1350 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 32, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW¼ SE¼, SECTION 32, T 2 S, R 38 E, WM; 640 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET EAST FROM S¼ CORNER SECTION 32.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.

- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. The ditch company shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The ditch company shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The ditch company shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

Certificate 32245 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
