Now, at this time, this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing:


That in the adjudication of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, water rights were adjudicated to Gilbert Philo for the diversion of two second feet under priority of 1880 for the irrigation of 97 acres of land, as follows: 33 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$, and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 10, Township 15 South, Range 10 East;

That rights were also adjudicated to M. W. Knickerbocker for the diversion of 1.44 sec. ft., under priority of 1908, for the irrigation of 72 acres of land, as follows: 7 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 38 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$; same section, township and range;

That M. W. Knickerbocker, as present owner of a portion of said lands, now proposes to exchange the water rights between two thirty acre tracts of said lands, as follows: 20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, having a water right with priority of 1880, to be transferred to 30 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$; and 30 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$, having a priority of 1908, to be transferred to 20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, all in Section 10, same township and range; that an inspection of this matter has been made by the local water master in accordance with law; And it further appearing that no other rights would be injured by such exchange;

Now, therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that said transfer
be and the same is hereby approved.
