IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF M. W. KNICKERBOCKER FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE CHANGE IN THE PLACE OF THE USE) ORDER OF WATER.

Now, at this time, this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing:

That in the adjudication of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, water rights were adjudicated to Gilbert Philo for the diversion of two second feet under priority of 1880 for the irrigation of 97 acres of land, as follows: 33 acres in the NW15W1, 342 acres in the SWASWA, 182 acres in the SEASWA, 92 acres in the NWASEA, and 12 acres in the SELSEL of Section 10, Township 15 South, Range 10 East;

That rights were also adjudicated to Mr. W. Knickerbocker for the diversion of 1.44 sec. ft., under priority of 1908, for the irrigation of 72 acres of land, as follows: 7 acres in the NW15W1, 52 acres in the SW2SW4, 212 acres in the SM2SW4 and 38 acres in the SW4SB2, same section, township and range:

That M. W. Knickerbocker, as present owner of a portion of said lands, now proposes to exchange the water rights between two thirty acre tracts of said lands, as follows: 20 acres in the NW1SW2 and 10 acres in the SW1SW1, having a water right with priority of 1880, to be transferred to 30 acres in the SW2SE2; and 30 acres in the SW2SE2, having a priority of 1908, to be transferred to 20 acres in the NWSW and 10 acres in the SWASW. all in Section 10, same township and range; that an inspection of this matter has been made by the local water master in accordance with law: And it further appearing that no other rights would be injured by such exchange:

Now, therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that said transfer be and the same is hereby approved.
