ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7300 submitted by

HERBERT R. VLOEDMAN, JR. P.O. BOX 44 SILVER LAKE, OR 97638.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 48731, was perfected under Permit G-6007 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 9, 1974. The right allows the use of the BOARDMAN WELL, a tributary of the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 19.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.24 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; LOT 2 (SW% NW%), SECTION 7, T 27 S, R 16 E, WM; 1430 FEET SOUTH AND 1380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 7, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 68444, was perfected under Permit G-10925 with a date of priority of APRIL 4, 1989. The right allows the use of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 46.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.58 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW½, SECTION 5, T 27 S, R 16 E, WM; 1320 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 5, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation for the water right developed under PERMIT G-10925 to:

LOT 2 (SW% NW%), SECTION 7, T 27 S, R 16 E, WM; 1430 FEET SOUTH AND 1380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 7

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of water diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificates 48731 and 68444 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued to confirm that portion of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
