ORDER

On September 21, 1967, Frank W. Groves submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in a certificate of registration; that he has abandoned said claim of water right and requests the same to be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 127 gallons per minute from a pump well located 1600 feet north and 980 feet west from the southwest corner of Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a beginning date of June 1929, for irrigation of 1.2 acres in the $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, 0.4 acre in the $NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, 13.2 acres in the $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M., and is described in the certificate of registration recorded in Volume 1, page 181, Ground Water Registration Records.

That part of the claimed right for the use of not to exceed 193 gallons per minute from the described well for irrigation of 25.2 acres in the $NW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ and 3.2 acres in the $NE_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M., and described in said certificate, is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 127 gallons per minute from a well located 1600 feet north and 980 feet west from the southwest corner of Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a beginning date of June 1929.
