IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF)	TRANSFER 5932
DIVERSION OF WATER)	

On April 9, 1987, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jim Young for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from Applegate River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered April 26, 1919, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Maud Kubli, tabulated in Volume 4, page 23, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, for use of not to exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second from Applegate River for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 0.9 acre in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23 and 2.5 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM, with a date of priority of 1866, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 52773, Volume 47, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Kubli Ditch, from a point located 2510 feet South and 3370 feet West from the Northeast Corner of DLC 39, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 1400 feet South and 380 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 26, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM; and to change the place of use to irrigation of 3.4 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper having general circulation in the area in which the water right is located, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 27, May 4 and 11, 1987.

Bruce R. Sund, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion are approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the subject water right is hereby severed from the place of use described in Certificate 52773, and shall be beneficially used as authorized by this order on or before October 1, 1988.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the right to divert water from the point described in Certificate 52773 is hereby canceled, and water shall be used from the new diversion point on or before October 1, 1988.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 52773, Volume 47, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
