On April 25, 1984, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John E. and Sharon A. Trujillo for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River and Crooked River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 51231, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of North Unit Irrigation District, describes a right which includes the use of water from Deschutes River, for irrigation of 3.7 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 24, Township 11 South, Range 13 East, WM, with a date of priority of February 28, 1913. Water for said Deschutes River right is diverted through the North Unit Canal. Said lands have a supplemental right from Crooked River under Certificate 51232.

The certificate recorded at page 51233, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of North Unit Irrigation District, describes a right which includes the use of water from Crooked River, for irrigation of 3.7 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 24, Township 11 South, Range 13 East, WM, with a date of priority of September 18, 1968.

Water for the said Crooked River right is diverted from a point located 590 feet North and 2790 feet East from the West Quarter Corner of Section 13, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 14 South, Range 13 East, WM.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to exchange the places of use of said Deschutes River right and said Crooked River right, both being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, Township II South, Range 13 East, WM.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of North Unit Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use at a regular meeting.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1985.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change in place of use shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to North Unit Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificates 51231 and 51233.
