ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3814

On October 4, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Harold Kraemer for approval of a change in point of appropriation from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

A water right was established by performance under the provisions of permit No. G-6668, in the name of Harold Kraemer, for the use of not to exceed 1.3 cubic feet per second from a certain ground water aquifer for irrigation of a certain 33.4 acres in SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 7; 7.4 acres in NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, 37.6 acres in SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 8; 2.1 acres in NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, 34.7 acres in NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, 13.5 acres in SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, 15.0 acres in SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ of Section 17; 35.8 acres in Lot 1 (NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄) and 3.4 acres in NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 18, 1974.

Water for the said right is diverted from a well located 1280 feet North and 200 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Lauren L. Thomas D.L.C. No. 48, being within the SE_4^1 SE_4^1 of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of appropriation therefrom, without loss of priority, to a well located 60 feet North and 600 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Lauren L. Thomas D.L.C. No. 48, being within the NW_4^1 NW_4^1 of Section 17, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Silverton Appeal-Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Marion Coutny, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 10, 17, and 24, 1978.

Mr. David Beach, Hydrogeologist, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

Mr. Keith Palmer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of appropriation under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of appropriation is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
