An affidavit was received from BAKER COUNTY COURT, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 26683, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 2.649 cubic foot per second from POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER. The date of priority is 1892 FOR 48.23 ACRES, 1891 FOR 50.0 ACRES, AND 1886 FOR 7.73 ACRES. The abandoned water right is for DOMESTIC, STOCK, AND IRRIGATION OF 105.96 ACRES.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:



TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 26683 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
