Under certain orders of the State Engineer heretofore entered approving changes in use, place of use and/or point of diversion of water of the above-named persons, the time limit was fixed to apply water to beneficial use and/or complete construction work, as provided by ORS 540.530.

No protests or objections to the granting of an extension of time have been filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the applications for an extension of time within which to complete the construction work and/or apply the water to beneficial use, be and the same hereby are approved and that said time hereby allowed each applicant is as set forth opposite his name in the foregoing tabulation.
