IN THE MATTER OF AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION, COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION, AND MAKE COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMIT NO. 20145 IN THE NAME OF THE CITY OF GLADSTONE.

The city of Gladstone is the holder of Permit No. 20145 to appropriate 4.0 second-feet of water from the Clackamas River for municipal use, and

The city has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation described in this permit has not been made, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development.

The city has further advised that they are actively engaged in a study to determine the most economical source of water. The South Fork Water Commission is the holder of Permit No. 22581 which proposes the construction of a filtration plant on the Clackamas River which would furnish water to the city of Gladstone as well as Oregon City, West Linn and adjacent areas. Action on construction under this permit No. 20145 is being held pending the completion of these plans, which if completed, would be the source of additional water for the city of Gladstone and the plans under this permit would be abandoned.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant the extension applied for and,

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that the time limits for the beginning of construction, completion of construction, and the complete application of water under this permit be and the same are hereby extended to October 1, 1957.
