ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6805 submitted by

WILLIAM C. TOOP P.O. BOX 501 JOHN DAY, OREGON 97845.

The first right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 39362. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1887.

The right allows the use of water of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 24.8 ACRES. This right is limited to 1/40th cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre foot per acre thereafter; total five acre feet per acre for the season, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW¼ NE¾, SECTION 27, T 13 S, R 29 E, WM; 50 FEET SOUTH AND 3380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 27, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 68334, was perfected under Permit 47460 with a date of priority of MARCH 30, 1983. The right allows the use of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 8.5 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.21 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW\(\frac{1}{4}\) NE\(\frac{1}{4}\), SECTION 27, T 13 S, R 29 E, WM; 50 FEET SOUTH AND 3380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 27, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

SW\(\frac{1}{4}\), SECTION 20, T 13 S, R 29 E, WM; 400 FEET NORTH AND 2950 FEET EAST OF THE WEST \(\frac{1}{4}\) CORNER, SECTION 20.

THIS CHANGE TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificates 39362 and 68334 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
