ORDER APPROVING ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6568 submitted by

JOYCE STEARNS BARNEY, SHIRLEY STEARNS BROWNING,
and ANN STEARNS RAMSEYER
dba STEARNS LAND COMPANY

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by Certificate 67548. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is APRIL 24, 1909.

The right allows the use of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 44.0 ACRES AND STOCKWATER. This right is limited to 0.55 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 18, T 16 S, R 16 E, WM; 445 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET EAST FROM THE W $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 18, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	22.8 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.3 ACRE
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	16.6 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	4.1 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	0.2 ACRES

SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

This right includes the use of such quantity of water as is reasonably necessary for household and stock use; and for stock use, the amount so diverted and used shall not exceed the rate of one-fortieth cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock; and the quantity diverted for irrigation during the irrigation season shall include when it is so diverted such amount as may be reasonably necessary for said stock and domestic purposes; and the right to divert and use the water for stock and domestic purposes continues throughout the year.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.
