## ORDER APPROVING ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6568 submitted by

JOYCE STEARNS BARNEY, SHIRLEY STEARNS BROWNING, and ANN STEARNS RAMSEYER dba STEARNS LAND COMPANY P.O. BOX 445 PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754.

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by Certificate 67548. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is APRIL 24, 1909.

The right allows the use of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 44.0 ACRES AND STOCKWATER. This right is limited to 0.55 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE\(\frac{1}{4}\) NW\(\frac{1}{4}\), SECTION 18, T 16 S, R 16 E, WM; 445 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET EAST FROM THE W\(\frac{1}{4}\) CORNER, SECTION 18, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SECTION 18

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

This right includes the use of such quantity of water as is reasonably necessary for household and stock use; and for stock use, the amount so diverted and used shall not exceed the rate of one-fortieth cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock; and the quantity diverted for irrigation during the irrigation season shall include when it is so diverted such amount as may be reasonably necessary for said stock and domestic purposes; and the right to divert and use the water for stock and domestic purposes continues throughout the year.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to add an additional points of diversion to:

SWA NEA, NWA SEA, SECTION 18, T 16 S, R 16 E, WM; 20 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET EAST; 50 FEET SOUTH AND 1220 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE CENTER A CORNER, SECTION 18.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 67548 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
