To date, there have been no protests received against the granting of an extension of time in which to begin construction and complete the project.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant the extension applied for and,

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that the time limits for the beginning of construction, the completion of construction, and the complete application of water under this permit be and the same are hereby extended to October 1, 1955 and October 1, 1956 respectively.
