ORDER

On November 12, 1964, Robert Tallman, Route 1, Box 515, Hood River, Oregon, submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.


The water right in question is for the use of water for power (hydraulic ram) for pumping water from Neal Creek for use in the SW¼ NE¼, SE¼ NE¼, and NE¼ SE¼, Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, W.M., as confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court for Hood River County, in the name of J. P. Thomsen with a date of priority of 1871, and is evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 3834, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The use of water for power (hydraulic ram) for pumping water was abandoned when a change in point of diversion was made and water from Neal Creek is now pumped by an electric pump.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second of water from Neal Creek with a priority date of 1871, for stock, domestic, and irrigation of 2.0 acres in SW¼ NE¼, 36.0 acres in SE¼ NE¼ and 27.0 acres in NE¼ SE¼, Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, W.M., is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right for the use of water for power (hydraulic ram) for pumping water from Neal Creek, is canceled.
