ORDER CANCELING A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT

An affidavit was received from James F. Butsch, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 34680, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.02 cubic foot per second from a well, a tributary of Butte Creek Basin. The date of priority is April 11, 1963. The abandoned water right is for irrigation 1.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

Certificate 34680 and the portion of the water right described herein are canceled. The remainder of the right is described in an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 10, 1992, approving Transfer 6481.
