ORDER CANCELING A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT

Affidavits were received from Lori Butsch-Pavliceck heir and devisee of Rose Butsch, and Jeff Butsch heir and devisee of Cletus Butsch, the owners of certain lands and the water rights appurtenant to them. The water rights have been abandoned and are requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water rights are a portion of the right described by Certificate 33461, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of a well, a tributary of Butte Creek Basin. The date of priority is May 1, 1961. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 4.6 acres. The quantity of water under this right will not decrease.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	1.7 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	2.9 ACRES

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

Certificate 33461 and the portion of the water right described herein are canceled. The remainder of the right is described in an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 10, 1992, approving Transfer 6481.
