ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. W-112

On February 23, 1965, James C. Wilson, Jr., filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to B. L. Dodge and recorded at page 27130, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right for the irrigation of, among other lands, 2.6 acres in the SEM SEM of Section 7; 3.6 acres in the SWM SWM of Section 8; 0.4 acres in the NWM NEM, 4.2 in the SWM NEM, 26.8 acres in the NEM NWM, 7.4 acres in the NWM NWM, 19.2 acres in the SEM NWM, 6.0 acres in the NEM SWM, 22.0 acres in the NWM SWM, 23.8 acres in the SWM SWM, 30.4 acres in the SEM SWM, 2.8 acres in the NWM SEM, 3.6 acres in the SWM SEM of Section 17; 1.0 acre in the NEM NEM, 26.2 acres in the SWM NEM, 21.0 acres in the SEM NEM, 34.4 acres in the SEM NWM, 29.4 acres in the NEM SWM, 32.0 acres in the NEM SEM, and 29.2 acres in the NWM SEM of Section 18, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 26, 1909.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 16.0 acres in the NEW SWW, 12.4 acres in the SWW SWW, 9.6 acres in the SEW SWW of Section 17; 15.0 acres in the SWW SEW, 15.0 acres in the SEW SEW of Section 18; 40.0 acres in the NEW, NEW, 25.0 acres in the NWW NEW, 20.0 acres in the SWW NEW, 40.0 acres

in the SEM NEW of Section 19; 6.0 acres in the SWM NEW, 15.0 acres in the NEW NWW, 20.0 acres in the NEW NWW, 30.0 acres in the SEM NWW, 30.0 acres in the NEW SWM, 5.0 acres in the NEW SWM, and 7.0 acres in the NEW SEM OF Section 20, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water only.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 2.6 acres in the SAM SEM of Section 7: 3.6 acres in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 8; 0.4 acres in the NW/4 N±/4, 4.2 acres in the SW/4 N±/4, 26.8 acres in the NEW NWW, 7.4 acres in the NWW NWW, 19.2 acres in the SEW NWW, 6.0 acres in the NEW SWW, 22.0 acres in the NWW SWW, 23.8 acres in the SWW SWW, 30.4 acres in the SEM SWM, 2.8 acres in the NWM SEM, 3.6 acres in the SWM SEM of Section 17; 1.0 acre in the NE%, NE%, 26.2 acres in the SWA NE%, 21.0 acres in the SEM NEMA, 34.4 acres in the SEM NWM, 29.4 acres in the NEM SWM, 32.0 acres in the NEW SEW, and 29.2 acres in the NW SEW of Section 18, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 16.0 acres in the NEW SW/4, 12.4 acres in the SW/4 SW/4, 9.6 acres in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 17; 15.0 acres in the SW/4 SE/4. 15.0 acres in the SEM SEM of Section 18; 40.0 acres in the NEM NEM, 25.0 acres in the NWA NEM, 20.0 acres in the SWA NEMA, 40.0 acres in the SEMA NEMA of Section 19; 6.0 acres in the SWA NEW, 15.0 acres in the NEWA NWWA, 20.0 acres in the NW/4 NW/4, 30.0 acres in the SW/4 NW/4, 20.0 acres in the SH/4 NW/4, 30.0 acres in the NE% SW%, 5.0 acres in the NW% SW%, and 7.0 acres in the NW% SE% of Section 20, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1967.

It is FURTHER ORDER D that certificate of water right heretofore issued to B. L. Dodge and recorded at page 27130, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and in lieu thereof, a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to James C. Wilson, Jr., confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
