O R D E R

On June 5, 1984, S.W. Groesbeck and W.R. Durbin Construction Company submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.


The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26691, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Paul K. Dyksterhuis, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second of water from Wet Dyke Well, with a date of priority of May 19, 1956, for irrigation of 19.7 acres in Lot 8 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) and 3.0 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 3 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26691, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

The said certificate of water right was canceled by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 28, 1979, canceling the balance of said right.
