ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE
AND A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6789 submitted by

JONNIE L. JUSTESEN AND FRED JUSTESEN
P.O. BOX 90
GRASS VALLEY, OREGON 97029.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 47965, was perfected under Permit G-6945 with a date of priority of JULY 28, 1976. The right allows the use of LOG YARD WELL, in the WHITE RIVER BASIN, for INDUSTRIAL USE, INCLUDING LOG DECK SPRINKLING. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.89 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 10, T 4 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 2720 FEET NORTH AND 3400 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 10, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the character of use to from INDUSTRIAL USE, INCLUDING LOG DECK SPRINKLING to IRRIGATION OF 71.2 ACRES.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 26.9 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 25.9 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 14.5 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.9 ACRES


TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2005.
2. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of March 1 to October 31 of each calendar year.

Certificate 47965 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
