O R D E R

Now, at this time, this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of W. F. Witham through his attorney, Mr. Ernest C. Smith, and it appearing:

That said W. F. Witham is the holder of Certificate No. 3426, issued under Permit No. 4195 of the State Engineer, covering the right to the appropriation of 0.2 second foot from an unnamed spring with priority of August 22, 1919, for the irrigation of 15 acres of land, as follows:

2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
3 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
10 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 10,
T. 2 N. R. 10 E. W. M.

That said applicant now proposes to transfer the water right now appurtenant to the 2 acre tract first described, to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 10;

That an inspection has been made of the premises involved in this proposed transfer by the water master of the district in which said land is situated, and his report and recommendations submitted in accordance with law, and it further appearing that this change can be made without injury to other water rights,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in the place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved.
