APPROVING APPLICATION

On May 22, 1941, Bert York, Dora Sherz, Rhoda Burcroff, Agnes Mensch, Maud Bebcock, and Josephine Gibson, heirs at last of Emily York, deceased, filed an application for approval of a change in place of use and point of diversion of water from Caris Creek.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, dated April 26, 1919, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the raters of Rogue River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of J. W. York for the irrigation of one acre in NEL SWL, Section 36, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W. M. with a date of priority of 1873 through the York Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 350 feet north and 100 feet west from the center of Section 36, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W. M. and being within the SEL NWL said section.

The applicants herein, owners of the above described land, propose to transfer the water right it prefrom to one-half acre in the SWA SEA and one-half acre in the SEA SEA, Section 25, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W. M. and to convey the water for the irrigation thereof through the Bert York Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 1370 feet north and 100 feet east from the SE corner of Section 25, Township 37 South, Evenge 5 West, W. M., and being within the WEA SEA, Section 30, Township 37 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., who given in the Grants Pass Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation, in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of at least three weeks and not less than one publication each week, being the issues of July 17, 24, August 1 and 8, 1941.

No objections having been filed, it appears that the proposed change in point of diversion and place of use of water may be made without injury to emisting rights and the application should be approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the time limit for application of water to beneficial use shall be fixed as October 1, 1943, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of the complete application of water to such beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Bert York, Dora Shars, Rhoda Burcroff, Agnes Mensch, Maud Babcock, and Josephine Gibson, heirs at law of Emily York, deceased, or their successors in interest to said lands, when and at the time certificates are issued in the matter of

the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Rogue River and its tributaries.
