Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.


Findings of Fact

1. On March 9, 2007, Cal Cannon, Shotgun Ranch, LLC, filed an application for two new storage locations and using a new point of diversion for the waters stored under Certificate 10841. The Department assigned the application number T-10336.
2. On March 5, 2008, Bruce A. Estes, Agent for Shotgun Ranch, LLC, requested on behalf of Shotgun Ranch, LLC that Transfer Application T-10336 be withdrawn.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Transfer Application T-10336, in the name of Cal Cannon, Shotgun Ranch, LLC, is withdrawn and of no further force or effect. Any unearned fees will be refunded.
