On April 16, 1991, the Special Order was entered at Volume 45, Pages 205 and 206 by the Water Resources Director canceling, among others, Permit  $49\bm{9}86$  .

An order of the Director is final after 60 days has passed from the date the order was entered. If the Director is petitioned within said 60 day period, all or a portion of said order may be reconsidered. The order may be amended if a request to reconsider is filed timely.

On May 23, 1991, a request to reconsider and reinstate Permit 49986 was received from James H. Cheek. The request was timely and showed cause why the permit should not have been canceled. The permit allowed for the use of 0.04 cfs of water from the North Umpqua River for irrigation of 2.93 acres. Mr. Cheek submitted a written statement that use was made under the terms of the permit.

The Special Order of the Water Resources Director entered April 16, 1991, at Volume 45, Pages 205 and 206, should be amended to delete the following permit from said order:
