An affidavit was received from Charles Joseph Ramos and John Brinker Ramos, owners of certain lands the water rights appurtenant to them. The water rights have been abandoned and are requested to be cancelled.

The first abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 5157. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.01 cubic foot per second from the Umatilla River, a tributary of the Columbia River. The date of priority is March 28, 1923. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 0.75 acre.

The second abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 7536. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.12 cubic foot per second from the Umatilla River, a tributary of the Columbia River. The date of priority is January 21, 1924. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 9.65 acres.

A description of the places of use of the abandoned water rights are as follows:
