ORDER

On August 30, 1963, Harry J. and Emily A. Plog submitted a sworn statement that they are the legal owners of a certain water right and the real property to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a part of that established by decree of the Circuit Court for Hood River County, entered October 24, 1921, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Hood River and its Tributaries, and confirmed by certificate recorded at page 15013, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the use of 0.5 cubic foot per second of the waters of Odell Creek for the development of 1.5 horsepower in the SW4 SW4, Section 14, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1887.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of water from Odell Creek for the irrigation of 11.0 acres in the NW_4^1 SW_4^1 and 7.0 acres in the SW_4^1 SW_4^1 , Section 14, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, W. M. is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second of the waters of Odell Creek for the development of 1.5 horsepower in the SW\(^1\) Sw\(^1\), Section 14, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1887, is canceled.
