ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 9295 submitted by

MARVIN CURRIE
BONITA L. MAPLETHORPE
17100 SWEET CIDER LANE SE
DAYTON, OREGON 97114.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 31303, was perfected under Permit G-2003 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 29, 1961. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the YAMHILL RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 34.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ SE¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CHRISMAN DLC 50, SECTION 21, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 8.5 CHAINS SOUTH AND 12.8 CHAINS WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 50, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2¼ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 11.2 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 22.8 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN CHRISMAN DLC 50
SECTION 21

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CHRISMAN DLC 50,
SECTION 21, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 52 FEET SOUTH AND 2187 FEET WEST
OF THE NE CORNER OF DLC 50.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2004.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
3. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 31303 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
