On September 29, 1978, Loy Gossler submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; and that he authorizes cancellation of said water right.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26099, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of J. J. Oberson and L. M. Gossler, and is for the use of water from Stanfield Drain, with a date of priority of November 18, 1947, for the irrigation of 2.2 acres in $NE\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26099, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
