DIMINUTION OF A WATER RIGHT)

On June 11, 1990, a request was received in the office of the Water Resources Director from Eugene L. Rose, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it, for approval of a change from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation from the waters of an unnamed slough.

Certificate 39850, State Record of Water Right Certificates, issued to Robert L. Leabo, describes a right for the use of 0.42 cubic foot per second from an unnamed slough with a priority date of March 16, 1959, for the irrigation of:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 12.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.0 ACRES

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 57


TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

It appears that the proposed diminution of water right may be made without injury to existing water rights. Therefore, the request should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the proposed change from primary to supplemental irrigation is approved without loss of priority.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that certificate 39850 is canceled and a new certificate be issued describing the use of water for supplemental irrigation on the same lands.
