ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6538 submitted by

PAUL SANSONE and SUSAN VOSBURG  
STAR ROUTE BOX 1038  
FOREST GROVE, OREGON 97116.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 22072, was perfected under Permit 21865 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 27, 1952. The right allows the use of GALES CREEK, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 26.2 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.33 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 5, T 1 N, R 4 W, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  10.5 ACRES  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  7.5 ACRES  
SECTION 5

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  5.2 ACRES  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  3.0 ACRES  
SECTION 8

TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicants propose to change the place of use of 2.1 acres from the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 5 to the following locations:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  1.6 ACRES  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  0.1 ACRE  
SECTION 5

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  0.3 ACRE  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  0.1 ACRE  
SECTION 8

TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The applicants also propose to change the point of diversion for the right involved in this transfer to two points located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 8, T 1 N, R 4 W, WM; 53 FEET SOUTH AND 244 FEET WEST, 175 FEET SOUTH AND 155 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE NORTH  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER OF SECTION 8.


THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 22072 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
