ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6209 submitted by

RAYMOND JAGER AND JAGER FARMS, INC.
28645 JAGER LANE
JUNCTION CITY, OR 97448

to use the waters of WELL 1 in the FLAT CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATING 16.0 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by Certificate 52067, was perfected under Permit G-6499 with a date of priority of JUNE 18, 1975. The right is limited to 0.20 cubic foot per second, if available from WELL 2 - NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55, SECTION 18, T15S, R4W, W.M.; 560 FEET SOUTH AND 550 FEET WEST FROM C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 18, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 54, SECTION 18, T15S, R4W, W.M.; WELL 1 - 20 FEET NORTH AND 1,590 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 54.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 9.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.6 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well 1) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (well 2).
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 52067 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
