ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6880 submitted by

SAM CROCKER, CROCKER FARMS
27118 HUBBARD ROAD
MONROE, OREGON 97456.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 38200, was perfected under Permit G-2591 with a date of priority of JANUARY 15, 1964. The right allows the use of WELL NO. 2, a tributary of the LONG TOM RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 67.3 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.75 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN THE RICHARDSON DLC 44, SECTION 15, T. 14S, R. 5W, W.M.; 1130 FEET NORTH AND 2420 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CONRER OF THE RICHARDSON DLC 44, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	9.1	ACRES

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	22.8	ACRES

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	5.2	ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	17.5	ACRES

AS PROJECTED WITHIN THE RICHARDSON DLC 44
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of appropriation to:

WELL NO.1, LOCATED SE¼ SW¼, SECTION 10, T. 14S, R. 5W, W.M.;2180 FEET NORTH AND 1149 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF DLC 44.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The new well shall be constructed so that it takes water only from the same aquifer as that of original well.

Certificate 38200 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
