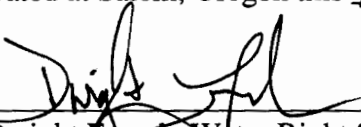
**Findings of Fact**

1. The Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-12120 on April 28, 2009. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 101, Page 121. A new remaining right certificate was also issued as evidenced by Certificate 91538.
2. Remaining right Certificate 91538 contains a scrivener's error in the table that describes the place of use of Dorena Reservoir to which the water right is appurtenant. The table describes the place of use of Dorena Reservoir as being within Townships 20, 21, and 22 South. The correct description of the place of use for Dorena Reservoir should be within Townships 20 and 21 South only.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. Water right Certificate 91538 is cancelled.
2. Water right Certificate 91586 is issued to supersede Certificate 91538 and to correctly describe the authorized place of use of Dorena Reservoir.
