ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3971

On June 9, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Richard Kirkham for approval of a change in place of use from South Yamhill River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By performance under the provisions of an order of the State Engineer approving water right transfer application No. 3568, a water right now exists for the use of not to exceed 1.18 cubic feet per second of water from South Yamhill River for irrigation of a certain 4.8 acres in SW14 NW14, 0.9 acre in NW14 SW14 of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; 8.4 acres in NE14 NE14, 0.3 acres in NW14 NE14, 6.2 acres in SW14 NE14, 39.6 acres in SE14 NE14, 23.0 acres in NE14 SE14 and 11.8 acres in NW14 SE14 of Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 11, 1938.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said right is located within the  $NE_4^1$   $NE_4^1$  of Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 4.3 acres in NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>, 30.8 acres in SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of Section 6; 15.0 acres in NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>, 38.8 acres in NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>, 3.0 acres in SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; 3.0 acres in NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> and 0.1 acre in SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> of Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Mr. Clifton R. King, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no new certificate of water right be issued as provided by the order of the State Engineer approving transfer application No. 3568; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
