ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6685 submitted by

LYNN SCHAAP
6242 SCISM ROAD N.E.
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 33743, was perfected under Permit G-1845 with a date of priority of MAY 3, 1961. The right allows the use of A WELL, a tributary of the BIG PUDDING RIVER (WILLAMETTE RIVER), for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.25 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within SIMMONS DLC 40, SECTION 30, T.6S., R.1W., W.M.; 630 FEET SOUTH AND 190 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER HEDRICK DLC 39, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.2	ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	15.2	ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	4.6	ACRES

all as projected within SIMMONS DLC 40
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


The applicant proposes to CHANGE THE POINT OF APPROPRIATION to NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within SIMMONS DLC 40, SECTION 30, T.6S., R.1W., W.M.; 125 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER SECTION 30.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 33743 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to describe that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
