ORDER CANCELING A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT

An affidavit was received from Norpac Foods, Inc., the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 35772, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of water from a Well (7), a tributary of the Little Pudding River Basin. The date of priority is June 13, 1962. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 8.7 acres. The quantity of water diverted will not change.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  8.7 ACRES  
SECTION 17  
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

The portion of the water right described herein and Certificate 35772 is canceled. The remainder of the right is described in an order entered JULY 6, 1992, approving Transfer 6540.
