STATEMENT

Water Right Permit G-2222 in the name of Wallace Glen Detering was canceled by special order of the State Engineer on May 5, 1966.

Permit G-2222 authorized the use of 0.77 cubic foot per second of water from a well for the supplemental irrigation of up to 61.3 acres of land.

The Director now makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of law and Order with respect to said Permit G-2222:

FINDINGS OF FACT

An authorization to cancel Application G-2265, Permit G-2222 was filed in the office of the State Engineer on October 22, 1965.

The State Engineer entered Special Order Volume 15, Pages 61 through 63, Special Order Records of the State Engineer on May 5, 1966, canceling Permit G-2222.

The Water Resources Department received letters explaining the events which resulted in the submittal of the cancellation authorization and requests Permit G-2222 be reinstated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The authorization to cancel the permit was submitted in error by the permittee and Permit G-2222 should be reinstated.

ORDER

It is ORDERED that Permit G-2222 is hereby REINSTATED to it's original status.
