Findings of Fact

- 1. The Department issued an order approving T-9078 on July 21, 2004. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 60, Pages 688-692.
- 2. The order incorrectly indicated the priority date of Certificate 52645 as May 21, 1981, when in fact the priority date is May 26, 1981.
- 3. The order incorrectly referred to Certificate 55707 in Finding of Fact #7, instead of Certificate 55705.
- 4. The order incorrectly indicated the instantaneous rate (quantity) of water being transferred under Certificate 80660 to be 0.215 cfs, when in fact the amount is 0.21 cfs.
- 5. The order incorrectly identified Certificate 80661 as the Certificate describing the remaining rights from Certificate 80660, however that Certificate number was already in use; no other changes were made and Certificate 80879 shall be issued to describe the remaining rights related to T-9078.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in an uncontested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The order approving T-9078 as recorded in Special Order Volume 60, Pages 688-692, is corrected as described in Findings of Fact #2 to 5 above.
- 2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
