Norma L. Quick submitted transfer application 5869 requesting approval of a change in point of diversion from the Umatilla River for the irrigation of certain lands. Special Order recorded in volume 44 at page 164 approved the change requested.

The order approving the change limited the diversion to a rate of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated and also limited the duty to 6.0 ACRE-FEET for each acre irrigated.

The Umatilla River Decree recorded in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, Volume 15, page 440 describes the water right in said transfer approval order to be subject to all conditions and limitations contained in said decree. A duty limited to 6.0 ACRE-FEET per acre was allowed for development of certain lands under said decree.

The lands described by the order approving said transfer do not qualify under said decree to receive a duty of 6.0 ACRE-FEET for each acre irrigated. The lands under said transfer qualify under said decree to receive a duty of 3.0 ACRE-FEET for each acre irrigated.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the order approving transfer 5869 is amended to describe a duty of water limited to 3.0 ACRE-FEET for each acre irrigated.
