ORDER APPROVING
APPLICATION NO. S-48

On December 16, 1946, J. A. Struss of Redmond, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, within the boundaries of the Central Oregon Irrigation District, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

In the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of the Central Oregon Irrigation District for the irrigation of, among other lands, 25 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 15 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of 20 acres of the above-described lands and water right appurtenant thereto, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that notice is not required in applications for only a change in place of use of water.


All lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Central Oregon Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of such District have approved the proposed transfer.

It appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and that the water rights hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 15 South, Range 12 East, W. M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use within the time fixed for the completion of the inchoate water rights allowed the Central Oregon Irrigation District in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, or such extension of time as may be granted in said matter by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
