ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6405 submitted by

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to use the waters of A WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 5.44 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 35784, was perfected under Permit G-2620 with a date of priority of MARCH 20, 1964. The right is limited to 0.001 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 38482, was perfected under Permit G-4039 with a date of priority of March 25, 1968. The right is limited to 0.066 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 4 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 1820 FEET NORTH AND 1230 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 5.44 ACRES  
SECTION 13  
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

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
THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans for the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The following described lands shall no longer be irrigated as a part of these water rights:

Certificates 35784 and 38482 are canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm that portion of each right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming these water rights will be issued.
