ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.252 and ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-7461 submitted by

ROGUE RIVER VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT
3131 MERRIMAN ROAD
MEDFORD, OREGON 97501-1277.

The permits to be modified are E-19, 407, 1705, 1706, and 30364.

The authorized place of use, under all the permits, is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 32.4 ACRES
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.0 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 14.2 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 6.9 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.3 ACRES
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

Proof, satisfactory to the Water Resources Director, has been received that the authorized place of use has been irrigated within the terms and conditons of the permits.

THIS CHANGE TO EXISTING PERMITS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE PERMIT HOLDER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed prior to October 1, 1997.



2. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of these permits.
3. All other terms and conditions of the permits shall remain the same.

Permits E-19, 407, 1705, 1706, and 30364 are amended as described herein. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, the lands described herein may be included in the certificates confirming these water rights.
