

Transfer Application 8850, in the name of Jack Yeager, was filed June 22, 2001. On May 1, 2006, Russell Rhoden, Manager of Ochoco Irrigation District, acting on behalf of the applicant, requested that Transfer Application 8850 be withdrawn because the application replicates the location and use of water rights authorized under the order approving Ochoco Irrigation District's ORS 541.329 petition. The final order approving Ochoco Irrigation District's ORS 541.329 petition to map the location and use of water rights is recorded in Special Order Volume 69, Page 170..

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

Transfer 8850, in the name of Jack Yeager, is withdrawn and of no further force or effect. Any unearned fees will be refunded.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
