O R D E R

On June 24, 1982, Robert Widmer, Mayor, City of Ontario, Oregon, submitted an affidavit that the City is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the City has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 11161, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Edgar S. Fortner, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.84 cubic foot per second of water from Snake River, with a date of priority of December 21, 1933, for irrigation of 13.6 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 3.3 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 47 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 11161, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
