ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6191 submitted by

RICHARD EGGER  
ROUTE 2, BOX 362  
HILLSBORO, OREGON 97123

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 6.16 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 20084 was perfected under Permit 18533 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 1, 1948. This right is limited to 0.077 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 2 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 775 FEET NORTH & 1325 FEET WEST AND 250 FEET NORTH & 1600 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.16 ACRES  
SECTION 1  
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:


1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable devise for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The following described lands shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4    5.20 ACRES  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4    0.96 ACRE  
SECTION 1  
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Richard Egger also affirms that he is the owner of land and the water right appurtenant thereto, which is for the use of 0.016 cubic foot per second for the irrigation of 1.3 acres under said water right within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of said Section 1; that he has abandoned said portion and requests it be cancelled. NOW, THEREFORE it is hereby ordered said portion of said water right is cancelled.

Certificate 20084 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved or cancelled by this transfer order. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
