ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6383 submitted by

WIL WILSON
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DAYTON, OREGON 97114

to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 8.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 70.4 ACRES.

A portion of the right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 51491, was perfected under Permit 32243 with a date of priority of APRIL 14, 1967. This right is limited to 0.48 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The remainder of the right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 51492, was perfected under Permit 34436 with a date of priority of MAY 28, 1969. This right is limited to 0.5 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The additional point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 51, SECTION 27, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1180 FEET SOUTH AND 2230 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

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A description of the place of use to receive water from the additional point of diversion is as follows:


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. In the interest of conserving the waters of Palmer Creek the supplemental portions of this right may be exercised as the primary right at times when Palmer Creek water is available.

^{error} Certificates 51491 AND 51492 are hereby canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm that portion of each right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
