



6. Permit Amendment Application T-13630 proposes additional points of appropriation as follows:

#### Permit Amendment Review Criteria

7. The changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
8. The proposed place of use is owned and/or controlled by the permit holder.
9. The changes do not enlarge the permit.
10. The changes do not alter any other terms of the permit.

#### Conclusions of Law


The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13630 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

#### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13630 are approved.
2. Permit G-18557, in the name of RED HILLS FARM, LLC, is issued to replace Permit G-15661, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order and the extensions of time. Permit G-15661, in the name of RED HILLS FARM LLC, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (Wells 2, 5, 6A, 6 and 7), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation (Well 8 and DT), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation (Well 8 and DT).
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18557 remain the same.
