## ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6384 submitted by

WIL WILSON 17900 MALLARD LANE, S.E. DAYTON, OREGON 97114

to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 48.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES.

A portion of the right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 35799, was perfected under Permit 31297 with a date of priority of JANUARY 24, 1966. This right is limited to 0.82 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The remainder of the right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 64200, was perfected under Permit 43642 with a date of priority of AUGUST 31, 1978. This right is limited to 0.03 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The new point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 26, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 900 FEET SOUTH AND 2270 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF LOT 13 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable devise for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. This right to use Willamette River water by diversion from an adjacent gravel pit is limited to the appropriation of the direct flow of the water of Willamette River. The right is limited to appropriation only to the extent that it does not interfere with the right to use of ground water by others.

Wil Wilson has submitted an affidavit affirming that he is the owner of all lands described by certificate 35799 and he has abandoned any interest in that portion not involved in this transfer and desires the abandoned portion be cancelled. Certificates 35799 and 64201 are hereby canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of certificate 64201 not involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
